iPad or iPhone

Launch Safari app.

Enter www.fletchersda.org into the address field. Tap Go.

- 1. Tap the icon featuring a right-pointing arrow coming out of a box along the top of the Safari window to open a drop-down menu.
- 2. Tap Add to Home Screen. The "Add to Home" dialog box will appear, with the icon that will be used for this website on the left side of the dialog box.
- 3. Enter the name for the shortcut using the on-screen keyboard and tap Add. Safari will close automatically and you will be taken to where the icon is located on your iPad's desktop.

Android

Launch the Chrome app.

Navigate to www.fletchersda.org.

- 1. Tap the menu icon (3 dots in upper right-hand corner) and tap Add to Home Screen.
- 2. You'll be able to enter a name for the shortcut and then Chrome will add it to your home screen.
