PLAYGROUND CAPITAL CAMPAIGN - The total cost for the new playground and picnic pavilion behind the church will be \$450,000. As of today \$180,340 has been raised, leaving \$269,660 still to go. This Sabbath marks the beginning of a five week campaign to double contributions each week. If you give \$20 this week, \$40 the next, and keep doubling for five weeks, you will contribute a total of \$620. If you start with \$500 this week and participate through the campaign, your total contribution will be \$15,500. The playground will make our church safer and more welcoming for children and their families. It will also provide an opportunity for us to serve and interact with our community.


